Listed below are a few ways that you, family members, co-workers and friends can help.

- 1. SORTING and PACKAGING OF FOOD BOXES** Over 25 of our Catholic Schools hold food collections for our program. We, in turn, put together food boxes for our families. PLEASE CALL TO SCHEDULE YOUR DATE AND TIME. We will meet on the following dates and times:

- 2. GIFT WRAPPING** The week prior to our delivery date, we need help to wrap presents and complete our gift boxes. The schedule is as follows:

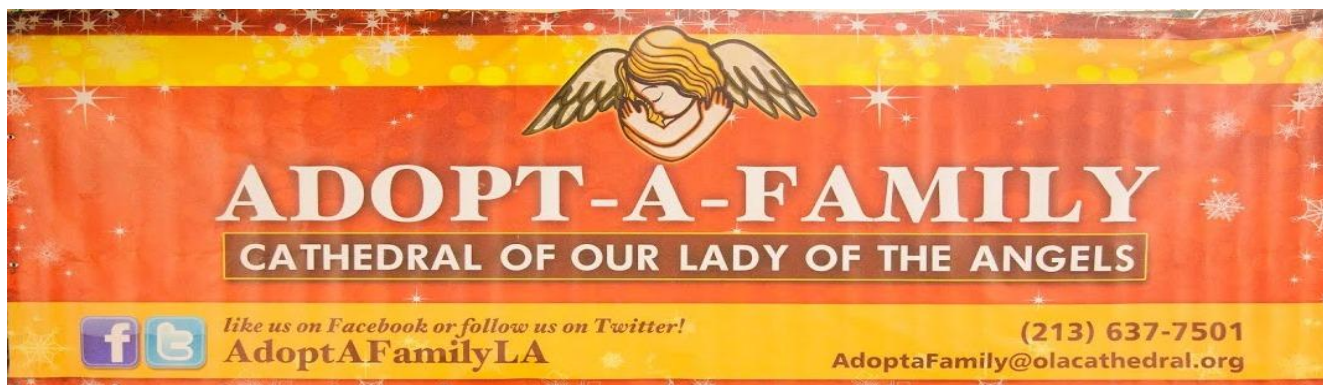

- 3. VARIOUS TASKS AND STAGING FOR DELIVERY DAY** –On *MONDAY, DECEMBER 11th* – *THURSDAY, DECEMBER 14th* our wonderful donors are dropping off gifts for our families and volunteers are needed

to help unload the many cars and trucks that come to the Cathedral. On **FRIDAY, DECEMBER 15th** we have to make sure that the gift boxes are ready for Delivery Day as volunteers will meet to pick up the gift boxes in the parking structure of the Cathedral the next morning. The staging takes many hands to make sure all the families have their boxes ready for delivery. We start the staging at 2:00 pm and setup in the parking structure (on level P-2) – and we usually are finished around 8:00 pm. The more hands in staging – the earlier we finish! So if you have time, please come out and help get the gift boxes ready for the next morning early delivery. If you have a group of volunteers that would like to volunteer on the staging, please give our office a call to arrange. The dates and times for unloading cars, last minute gift wrapping and staging are as follows.

5. **DELIVERY DAY – SATURDAY, DECEMBER 16th** Gift boxes, filled with Christmas Magic, are delivered to the families. We meet at the Cathedral and begin with a very short prayer service led by Archbishop Gomez. We then load up our trucks and large cars to make the deliveries. We are in special need of volunteers with trucks or very large cars. If this is something you would like to do, please come join us at the Cathedral on DECEMBER 16th at 7:00 am. We start early and finish up before 11:00 am.
